## SERVICE BULLETIN PA210/220/222/230/232/246/248 **Seal Kit Installation Instructions**

**WARNING:** Only a qualified electrician or authorized service representative should perform this work. Disconnect the oven from all electrical power before cleaning, performing maintenance or service work. Danger of electrical shock exists if this instruction is ignored. DO NOT ATTEMT TO WORK ON AN OVEN THAT IS HOT, SERIOUS BURNS MAY RESULT.

## TOOLS REQUIRED: Phillips Screwdriver, Paint Scrapper

- 1. Loosen the Metal Strips holding the door seal enough so that you can slide the old seal out.
- 2. Scrap off any remnants of the seal with the Paint Scrapper.
- 3. Starting at bottom corner, install new seal with the circle resting on the outside. (See Figure 1)
- 4. Tighten down metal strips being careful not to over tighten. (See Figure 2)
- 5. Loosen the Metal Strip across the bottom of the door so you can get that seal out.
- 6. Install new seal with flat side against the door. (See Figure 3)
- 7. Tighten down the metal strips being careful not to over tighten.


